

DIR-412 Virgin Broadband - 3G Settings

Below is the requirements for Optus 3G Broadband:

Once you have logged into <http://192.168.0.1/> click on the "Manual Internet Connection Setup", unselect the Auto Config option and enter the configuration as per below:
