Step 2

Download the free mydlink Lite app from the App Store or Google Play by searching for **mydlink** Lite. If you have a QR code reader app, you can simply scan the QR code for your device.



Open the mydlink Lite app, enter your mydlink e-mail and password, then tap the **Sign in** button.

Step 4

Tap on your mydlink-enabled device from the Device List that appears, and you will be able to access it.







mydlink SharePort

The mydlink SharePort app lets you create your own personal cloud storage; just plug a USB storage drive into your mydlink-enabled router, and stream photos, music, videos, and more directly to your mobile device locally or over the Internet!

Note: For an optimal streaming experience over the Internet, you will need at least 2 Mbps of upload bandwidth for your router's Internet connection.

Supported file formats for iOS (Android support depends on available installed apps):

- Video: .mp4, .mov, .m4v
- Music: .mp3, .wav, .m4a

Step 4

Open the mydlink SharePort app on your device, and the login page should appear.

If you are connecting directly to your router's wireless network, select Local Access and enter the Admin password of your router, then tap Log In.

If you are connecting through the Internet, tap Remote Access and enter your mydlink Account name and Password, then tap Log In.

You can now use the mydlink SharePort app to access and share files stored on your USB drive. Please note that when using Remote Access, streaming performance will vary depending on the quality of your Internet connection.
