



Modem driver installation on Windows 2000


1. Insert the modem card to the Laptop.
2. Windows 2000 will find this new hardware.




3. It will install it as the standard modem as default.




4. Go to \ControlPanel\System\Hardware, and select Device Manager.



5. Select Properties of "Standard PCMCIA Card Modem".




6. Select "Update Driver".



7. Specify correct path of the driver disk (A:\).



8. If the driver is correct, the path will be shown as below.



9. There will be a screen which displays “Digital Signature Not Found” message. However, it is not necessary for this modem. And the modem can work well as on Win95/98.



10. After installing the driver, the Update Device Driver Wizard will inform you the completion of updating.
