Installing the Drivers

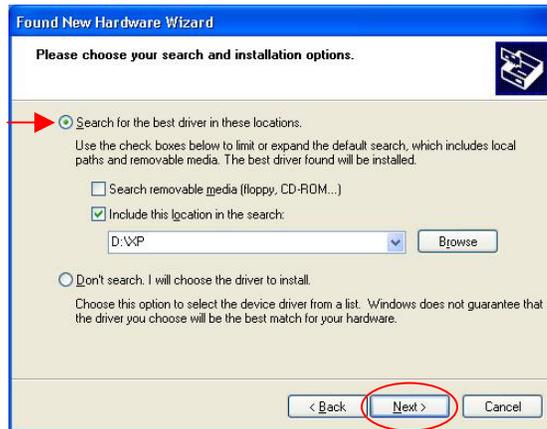


- **Turn ON** the laptop computer.
- **Insert** the DWL-650 Wireless PC Adapter into an available PC Card slot in the laptop.
- The “**New Hardware Wizard**” screen will appear.
- Select “**Install from a list or specific location (Advanced)**”
- Click **Next**

NOTE: If this screen does not appear, go to **Start > Control Panel > Switch to Classic View > Add Hardware**. Double-click on the icon.

Installing the Drivers (continued)



- Select “**Search for the best drivers in these locations.**”
- **Browse** for the drivers on the driver CD i.e. **D:\XP** where D: refers to the CD-ROM drive
- Click **Next**



- Click on **Continue Anyway.**

(D-Link software is currently undergoing Windows Logo testing. Microsoft certification is pending.)

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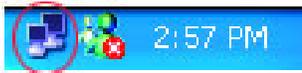
Installing the Drivers *(continued)*



- Windows will load the necessary files.
- Click **Finish** to complete the installation.

- **NOTE:** If unable to view the wireless networks, please re-insert the wireless PC card.

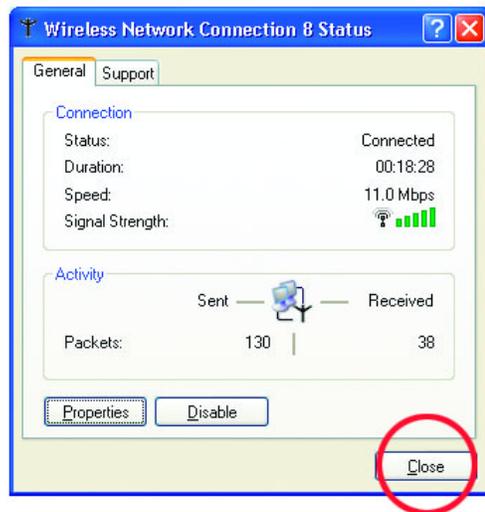
Connecting to the Wireless Network



- Select the wireless network. In this case, **default** is selected.
- Click **Connect**



- The taskbar will display the status of the wireless network.
- Double-click on the icon.



- The status of the wireless connection will be displayed.
