

Installing the Hardware




Step 1

Connect one end of an Ethernet cable (included with your package) to the LAN 1 (PoE) port on the **DWL-8200AP**, and the other end of the Ethernet cable to the port labeled P+DATA OUT on the PoE base unit.

Step 2

Connect another Ethernet cable from the DATA IN port on the PoE base unit to your router/switch or to a PC.




Step 3


Attach the power adapter to the connector labeled POWER IN on the PoE base unit. Attach the power cord to the power adapter and into an electrical outlet.

Mounting Plate Assembly


Step 1: Insert provided wall anchors in the wall where the mounting plate will be attached.



Step 2: Use the provided screws to secure the mounting plate on the wall.




Step 3: Attach the remaining screws securely to the back of the DWL-8200AP.




Step 4: Attach the DWL-8200AP to the mounting plate.



Step 5: Slide the DWL-8200AP down into the grooves on the mounting plate to secure it to the plate.
