Web Filtering

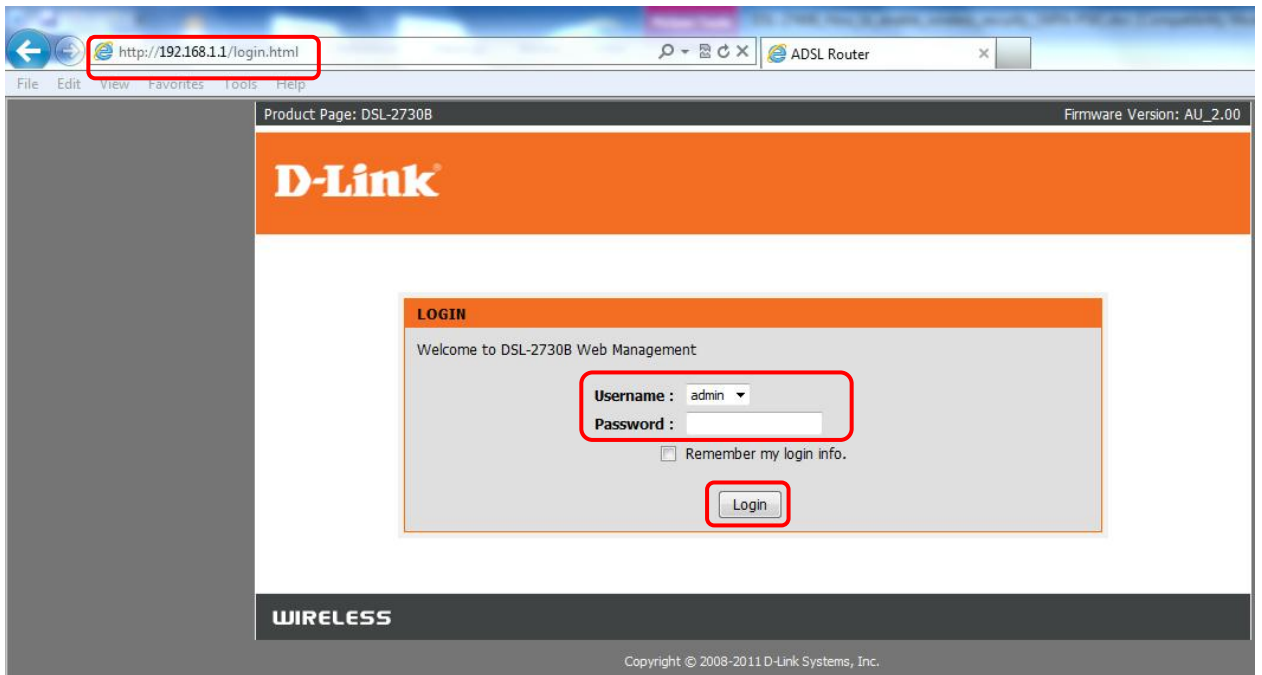


This document will detail how to configure Web Filtering on the following models
DSL-2730B Revision T1 Firmware AU_2.00
DSL-2740B Revision F1 Firmware AU_2.00
DSL-2750B Revision B1 Firmware AU_2.00

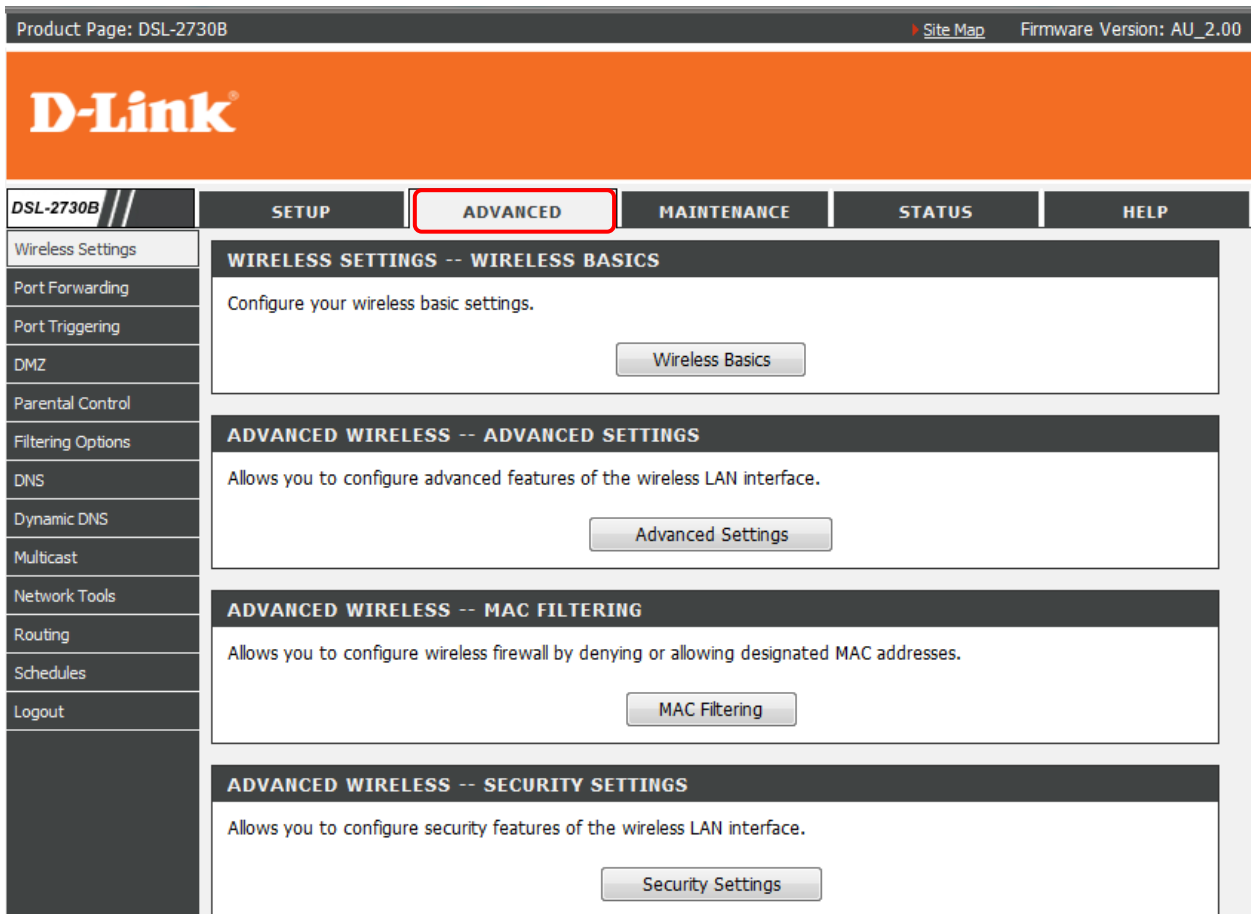
NOTE:

The Web Filter feature cannot be configured to block websites to specific computers. All computers on the network will be affected by the filter.

1. Log in to the modem with the computer connected to the modem via Ethernet.
 - URL: <http://192.168.1.1> (default)
 - Username: admin
 - Password: admin (default)



2. Select the **ADVANCED** button in the top menu.



3. Select **PARENTAL CONTROL** in the left menu, followed by the **Block Website** button.

 - Select **Schedule** if you wish to set the filter to 'always' block the site or select a pre-configured schedule.
 - Select **Manual Schedule** to create a new schedule in which the site will be blocked.
