



## IPTV setup on DSL-2740B/DSL-2750B



*This document will detail how to setup IPTV on the DSL-2740B H/W: F1 and DSL-2750B H/W: B1 models.* 

IPTV is a multimedia service (television/video/audio....) delivered to you over IP based networks.

This guide will assume you already have an active connection to the Internet. If you don't have Internet connectivity please run the included Setup CD-ROM or manually via the Web Configuration to first establish a connection to the Internet.

1. Login to the Web Configuration of your DSL-2740B/DSL-2750B. By default the IP address is <a href="http://192.168.1.1">http://192.168.1.1</a>.

2. Login with your admin username and password when prompted. *This is not your Internet Service Provider Username and Password*.



3. Click on SETUP > Internet Setup > ATM. Click on the 'Add' button:

- 4. For the ATM PVC Configuration select the following:
- \* VPI: 0
- \* VCI: 35
- \* Select DSL Link Type: EoA
- \* Select Connection Mode: MSC Mode Multiple Service over one Connection.

Followed by clicking on the Apply/Save button. Illustration below:
