## Forgot Wireless Security Password



This document details how to locate your Wireless Security Password

1. Open your Internet Browser and in the address field type http://192.168.1.1.



2. Type in the Username and Password you assigned to your modem when you were setting it up. If you did not change them, the factory defaults are:


Username: admin Password: admin

If you cannot recall the password you assigned to your modem you will need to reset the modem to factory defaults by pressing the reset button for 10 seconds. Please note that this will revert all the settings in the modem to factory settings and you will have to reconfigure it with your Internet settings and Wireless security.


3. You should now be presented with your modem's configuration pages:




4. Please click on Setup > Wireless Settings > Manual Wireless Connection Setup button:




5. Scroll down to middle of the page, to the Wireless Security Mode section:



If the Security Mode is set to **[None]**, it means there is no Wireless Security Password configured for this modem. Your wireless network is open to everyone.



If the Security Mode is set as [WEP], [WPA] or [WPA2], it means your wireless network is protected with a password.



The Entry inside the [Pre-Shared Key] section or [WEP Key 1] is your Wireless Security Password.
