

DSB-R100 installation in Windows XP

Download Windows XP driver from

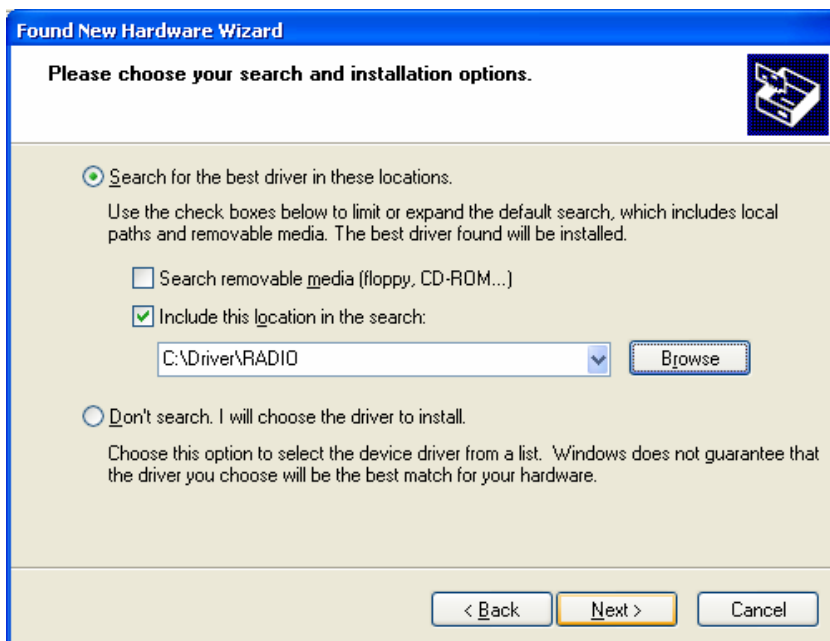
<http://www.dlink.com.au/tech/drivers/files/usb/dsbr100.htm>

Unzip the files into a temporary folder (in our example it is C:\Driver\Radio). Connect USB Radio to the USB port of your computer. “Found New Hardware” window will pop up. Select **“Install from a list or specific location (Advanced)”**:



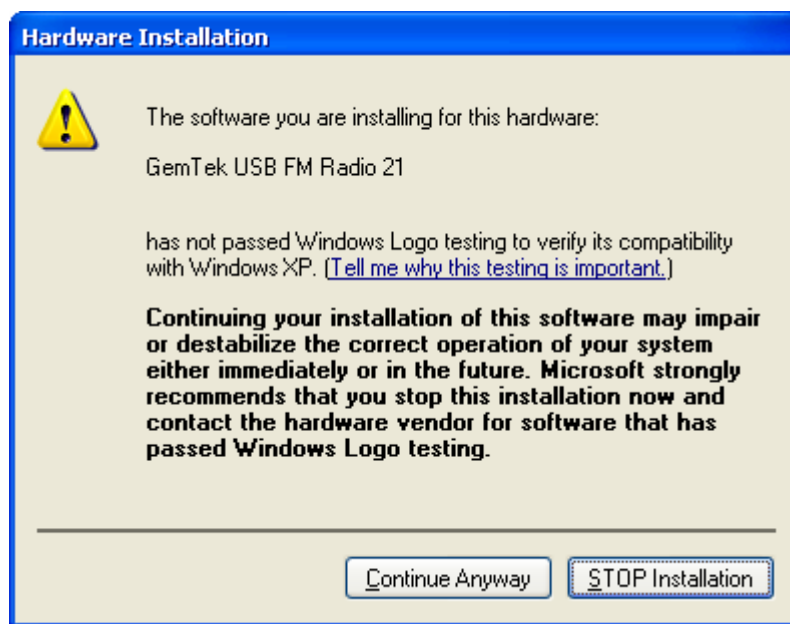
Click in Next.

In next window put a tick next to **“Include this location in the search”** and click on **“Browse”**. Open the folder where you extracted the drivers to (in our example it is C:\Driver\Radio). Click on OK:

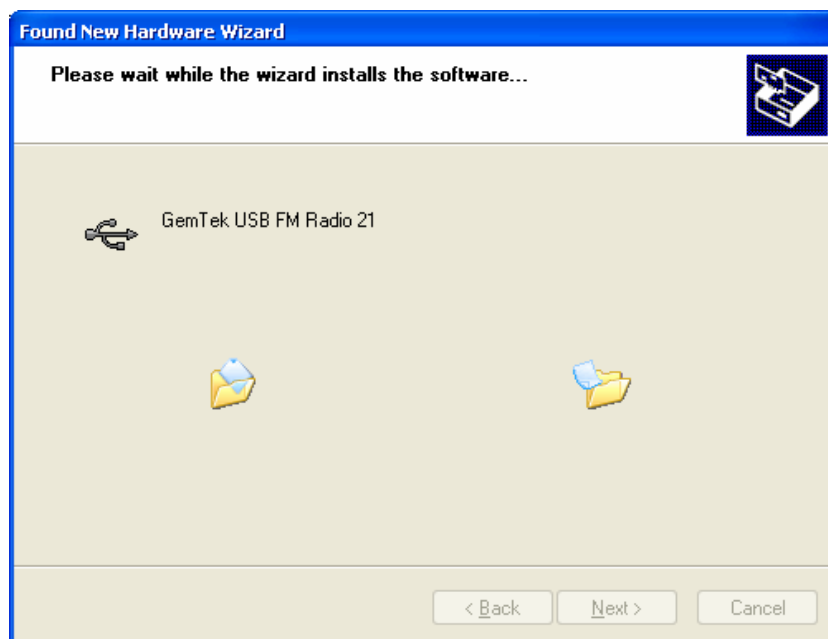


Click on “**Next**”.

Windows will search for the driver and will display this message:



Click on “**Continue Anyway**”.



Windows will start copying files.

After driver installation click on “**Finish**”:



Restart your computer.

If you wish you can use a freeware program with this radio (it is called “**Radiator**”). It can be downloaded from <http://flesko.cz/>

Here is how the program can be setup for DSB-R100 radio:
