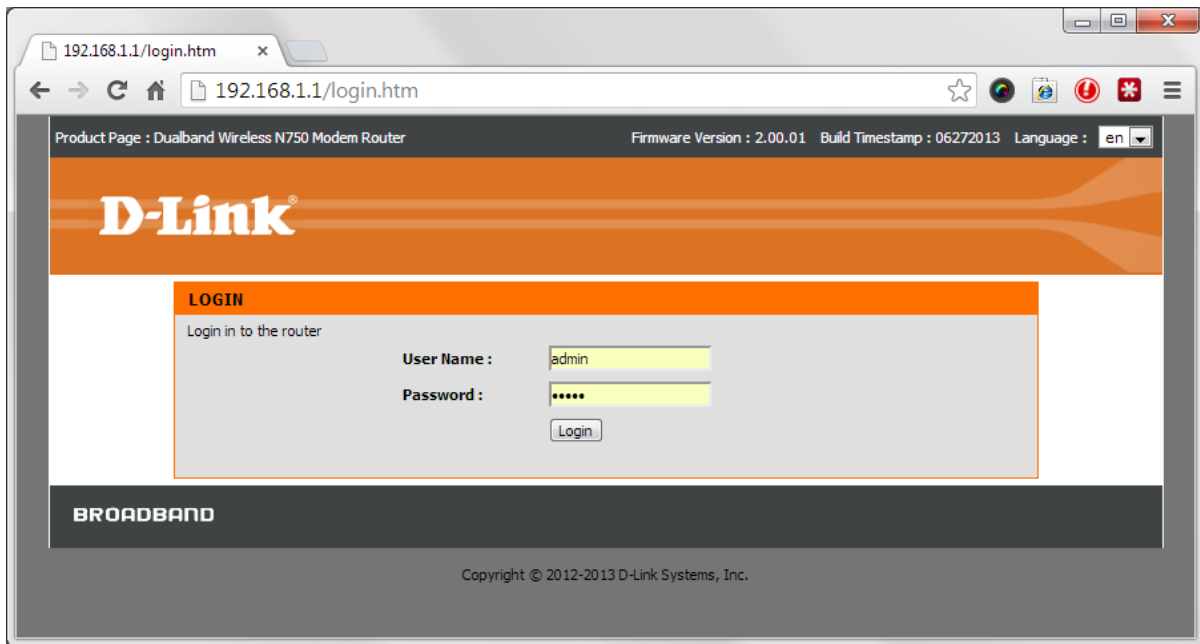


# How to change ADSL Username and Password in your modem router

*This document details how to change ADSL Username and Password settings stored in your modem*

**Step 1.** Open your Internet Browser and in the address field type in <http://192.168.1.1>.

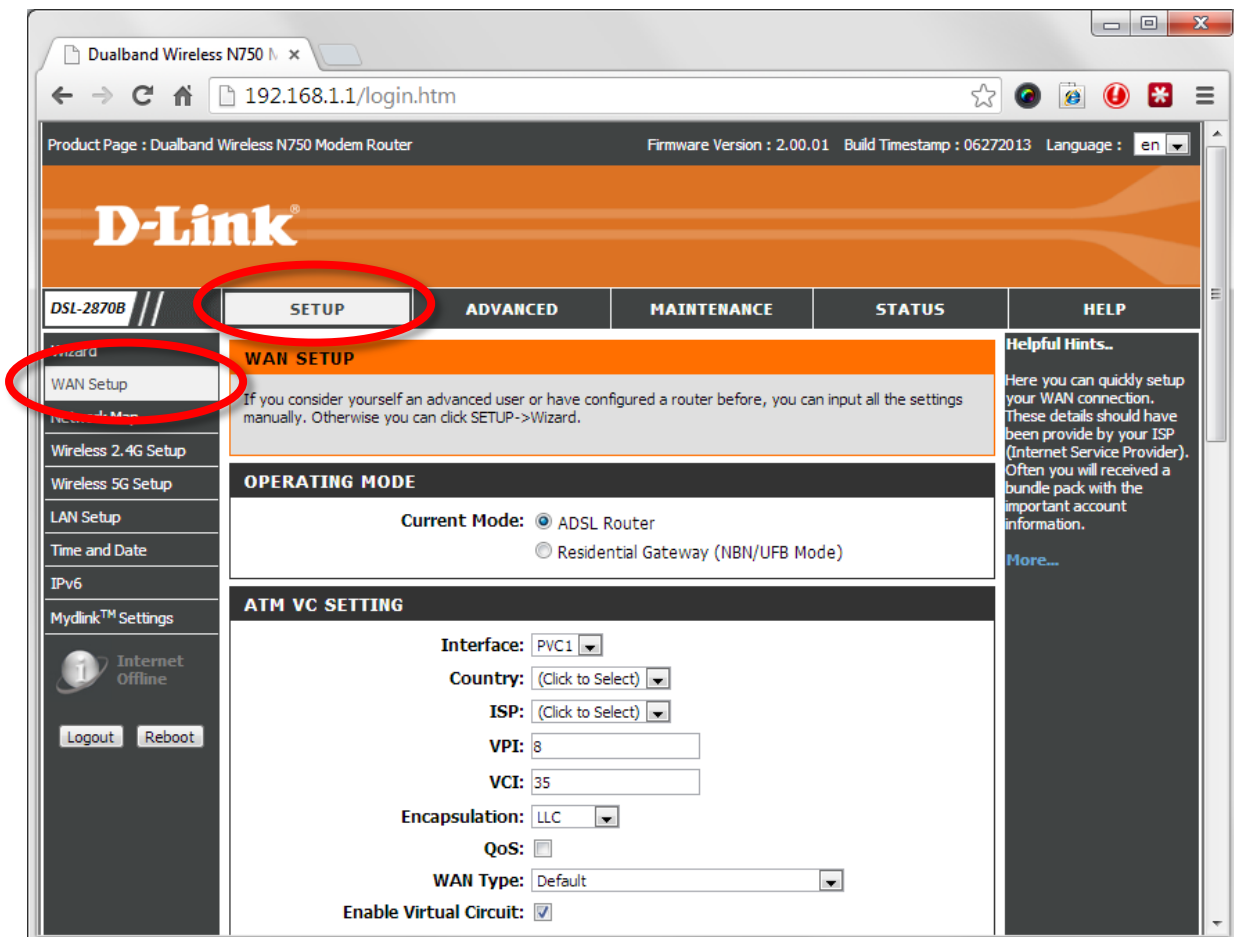


**Step 2.** When prompted type in the Username and Password then click on the “Log In” button. If you have not changed the password for the modem administration, the factory settings are:

Username: admin

Password: admin

**Step 3.** After logging in you will be presented with the modem’s configuration pages. Please click on **[Setup]** tab, and then click on **[Wan Setup]**:



**Step 4.** Scroll down to the **WAN** section of the page.

In the **Username** field type in the username as given by your Internet Provider.

In the **Password** field type in the password as given by your Internet Provider. Re-type your password in the **Confirm Password** field.
